Outright Gifts for the Campaign

When you make an outright gift to Petawa, your contribution can be put to work immediately.

Cash gifts can be made through credit/debit card transactions, outright cash, or personal checks made payable to Petawa Cultural Center. Gifts may be a one-time contribution or as part of a five-year pledge. Visit www.petawa.org/donate.

Gift Pledges may be made to Petawa for any term. The Petawa Cultural Center welcomes your campaign gift through a pledge — a formal statement of intention to make a gift to Petawa. With a pledge, you may complete your gift by making regular payments over time, allowing you to give more generously than you originally may have considered. What is more, each payment on your pledge is eligible for an income-tax charitable deduction. Petawa requests that pledges to the campaign be fully paid by December 31, 2025.

Matching Gift programs may be available through your place of employment, allowing you to double or triple your generosity.

Gifts of appreciated securities, stocks, and bonds also provide considerable tax advantages when transferred to Petawa before they are sold. Transferring securities held long term to Petawa allows you to make a gift and receive a charitable deduction equal to the full, fair market value of the securities. You pay no capital gains on your gift and neither does Petawa. In order for Petawa Cultural Center to acknowledge your gift and provide you with an IRS receipt, please call Beth Griffin at 262-337-2977 to let us know that you would like to make a gift of stock.

IRA Charitable Distribution may be an option if you are 70 ½ of older, satisfying all or part of your required minimum distribution with a gift to Petawa.

Gifts of real estate including personal residences, second homes, income property, and vacant land offer a wide variety of tax and other benefits.

Petawa Legacy Society – Planned Giving

Members of the Petawa Legacy Society have included the Petawa Cultural Center in their will or estate plans. A bequest can be made to Petawa by including the following language in your will or estate planning document:

Use of your gift is designated by you. When giving to Petawa, you can designate your gift as unrestricted or directed.

Unrestricted gifts are among the most valuable to Petawa, because they allow Petawa to allocate funds wherever the need is greatest and to take advantage of opportunities as they arise.

Directed gifts allow you to designate your gift for a specific program or space.
